

Top 20 Things to Know about Kamala's record as VP

- 1.VP has held hundreds of events since her swearing-in.
- 2.So far in 2024, VP has visited 20 states with multiple trips to 14 states. She has made more than 60 trips to communities across America
- 3.VP has led not only at home but also abroad during trips to Ghana, Tanzania, Zambia, Germany, The Bahamas, Indonesia, the UAE for COP28, and the United Kingdom for the first-ever Global AI Summit.
- 4.Vice President Harris has now represented the United States in 20 countries while on 15 different foreign trips.
- 5.She has met with more than 150 world leaders to strengthen America's alliances
- 6.Leads the administration's efforts on maternal health, resulting in 47 states plus DC expanding post-partum Medicaid coverage from 60 days to 12 months; the launch of the National Maternal Mental Health Hotline, which has connected nearly 38,000 individuals to free, confidential, 24/7 support; and more reforms ([source](#)). VP was the first to ever introduce a Senate bill to specifically address the issue of Black maternal mortality ([Maternal CARE Act](#)). She also proposed funding for uterine fibroid research, an issue that more than 80% of Black women are diagnosed within their lifetime. ([Source](#)).
- 7.Chair of the White House Task Force on Worker Organizing and Empowerment which mobilizes the federal government's policies, programs, and practices to empower workers to organize and successfully bargain with their employers. ([source](#))
- 8.Chair of the National Space Council which advises and assists the President on the development and implementation of space policy and strategy ([source](#))
- 9.Oversees the first-ever White House Office of Gun Violence Prevention where she is pushing for commonsense gun safety laws at the state and federal levels. ([source](#))
- 10.Leads the administration's response to reproductive rights being under assault- from leading over 50 convenings in at least 16 states and embarking on a Reproductive Freedoms tour. ([Source](#))

11. Leads the administration's efforts to eradicate lead pipes over the next decade ([source](#))
12. Leading the administration's efforts on reducing medical debt, which would remove medical debt from credit reports of more than 15 million Americans ([source](#))
13. Leading the administration's efforts to reduce homeownership appraisal bias ([source](#))
14. Stemming from funding Vice President Harris secured during her time in the Senate, Treasury has awarded over \$1.7 billion in grants to more than 600 Community Development Financial Institutions (CDFIs) across the country ([Source](#))

Leads the administration's efforts to modernize and implement a clean school infrastructure to upgrade our public schools with modern, clean, energy-efficient facilities and transportation ([Source](#)). 17. VP has cast a record number of tie-breaking votes in the Senate ([Source](#))

19. Juneteenth, which became law during the Biden-Harris administration, was first introduced as a federal holiday by then-Senator Kamala Harris in 2020 ([Source](#))

VP Kamala Harris revived the push to make lynching a federal crime, successfully passing anti-lynching legislation in the Senate for the first time in 2018 after 200 failed attempts in prior Congresses ([Source](#)).
